Puerto Rico

US Territory— No Passports Required

Travelers entering any of the Island's three open airports, whether on commercial or private aircraft, are required to fill out a Travel Declaration Form on the Puerto Rico Health Department's [online portal](#) which produces a QR code required to proceed. Both international/not vaccinated travelers must also upload a negative PCR molecular or antigen COVID-19 test result to the portal. Fully vaccinated travelers entering on domestic flights are permitted to upload their vaccination card instead of a negative test. Given federal mandates, the requirement will remain in place for travelers on international flights. All passengers will also be required to present their ID to ensure alignment with the information entered within the Travel Declaration Form.

For those who must present a negative COVID-19 PCR or antigen test, the protocol is as follows:

For fully vaccinated travelers on domestic flights:

- Required to upload their official Vaccination Card, as proof of vaccination through the Travel Declaration Form portal. A copy will not be accepted.

For non-vaccinated travelers arriving on domestic flights:

- Required to provide evidence of either a PCR molecular or antigen COVID-19 test taken within 72 hours of arrival.
- If the traveler arrives without a test, they must upload either a PCR molecular or antigen COVID-19 test taken on the Island, within 48 hours of arrival, or they will receive a \$300 fine.
- If the uploaded result is negative, the quarantine is lifted. If the result is positive, the person must isolate and follow the local isolation protocol at his/her own expense.

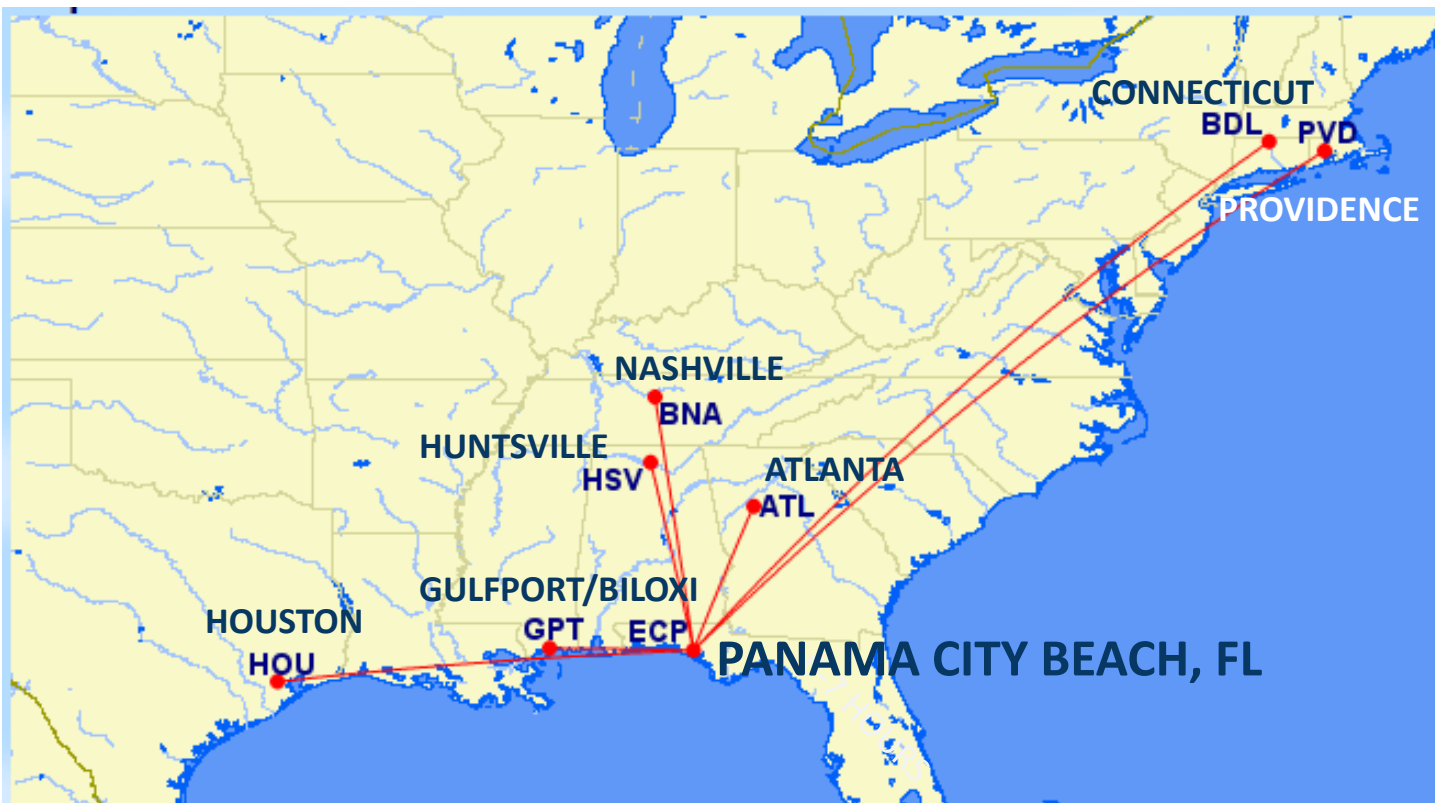
INTERNATIONAL DESTINATIONS— REQUIRES PASSPORTS

Bahamas	In the Bahamas, effective May 1, all arriving international travelers who are fully vaccinated [and have passed the two-week immunity period] will be exempt from ALL testing requirements. Non-vaccinated guests are required to submit a valid, negative Polymerase Chain Reaction [PCR] test completed no more than 5 days prior to travel. If non-vaccinated guests are staying longer than 5 days then they will be required to take a COVID-19 Rapid Antigen Test on day 5 of their visit. All travelers must apply for a Bahamas Health Travel Visa at travel.gov.bs , complete a daily online health questionnaire for symptom tracking purposes and opt-in to mandatory COVID-19 health insurance when applying for their Health Travel Visa. Jamaica	In Jamaica, travelers arriving from the U.S. will be required to present either a negative Polymerase Chain Reaction [PCR] OR Antigen test on arrival to the airport. Children aged 11 years or younger will not be required to present a negative test. Please note, travelers are no longer required to upload their negative test prior to arrival. Travelers are still required complete the mandatory Travel Authorization form AND receive government approval before departing. Approval will be sent to you immediately after completing your Travel Authorization, and you must present this approved form upon departure from the U.S. We urge you to visit VisitJamaica.com for more information.

ESCAPE TO SHELL ISLAND AND EXPERIENCE THE NATURAL BEAUTY OF FLORIDA. WHERE SAND DUNES, MILES OF PRISTINE WHITE SAND, PINE HAMMOCKS, AND RELAXATION AWAIT YOU.

A vacation to Panama City Beach would not be complete without a trip over to Shell Island, a seven-mile-long undeveloped barrier that's positioned right between the Gulf of Mexico and St. Andrews Bay.

The island is divided and protected between the ownership of St. Andrews State Park and Tyndall Air Force Base, and, although it has an island appearance, it is technically a peninsula.

With no distractions such as vendors, restrooms, or shelters, you can truly soak in the raw beauty of the island. Not to mention, you will be running on Island Time, where your worries will float away as you escape the hustle of everyday life.

Whether you are going for a full day or a few hours, be sure to go prepared with plenty of snacks, water, sun protection, floats, and a camera to capture the sites you will encounter. It is the perfect home for deer, nesting shorebirds, and all manner of coastal

creatures, including ghost crabs and endangered species such as Choc-tawhatchee Beach Mice, piping plovers, snowy plovers, and loggerhead and green sea turtles.

Just a short boat ride away, you can access the island by a pontoon or jet-ski rental or by one of our many tour boats that shuttle passengers to Shell Island. During the peak of the summer season, shuttles run seven days a week; however, off-season schedules vary, so be sure to call ahead and check.

locally secrets

Get to the beach early for the best place to lay out on the sand and for a preferred parking spot.

Go to the Summer Concert Series, Thursday nights in June-August at Aaron Bessant Park. Be sure to bring a cooler full of drinks and snacks and a blanket or a lawn chair.

"Back Beach" is both PCB Parkway and Highway 98, and "Middle Beach" is Hutchison Boulevard.

Take a boat ride out to Shell Island.

Cruise Front Beach Road for the scenery. Cruise Back Beach Road (Highway 98/PCB Parkway) for faster traveling time.

We prefer the comfort and convenience of beach chairs instead of towels.

Wear sunscreen. We promise you won't miss out on a bronze glow — you'll thank us later.

You can still enjoy perfect beach weather in the fall.

Visit Historic St. Andrews over the bridge in Panama City.

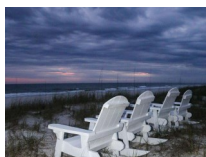

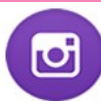
